Dear colleague,

We are pleased to invite you to attend the STRENGTHS research symposium in Amsterdam, at the Vrije Universiteit, on <u>Friday, 10 June 2022, at 09:00 (GMT +2)</u>. <u>The STRENGTHS project</u> (Scaling up psychological interventions with Syrian refugees) trained Syrian refugees to provide scalable psychological programmes developed by the World Health Organization (WHO), targeting symptoms of common mental disorders.

STRENGTHS evaluated the implementation, effectiveness and cost-effectiveness of these scalable programmes for Syrian adult and child refugees across Jordan, Lebanon, Turkey, Egypt, the Netherlands, Germany, Sweden and Switzerland.

The symposium will integrate the most important and novel research findings from all partners and provide information about the training and next steps in implementation. The programme is provided on the next page.
